DO NOT use this machine unless you are trained in its safe operation and have been given permission by a supervisor



Safety glasses must be worn at all times in work areas



Long and loose hair must be contained



Safety footwear must be worn at all times in work areas



Close fitting/protective clothing must be worn

Pre-Operational Safety Checks

1. Check that bag and skate testing tags
2. Make sure there are no rips in air bags
3. Check how much psi is required
4. Pipes are out of the way when connected
5. Check the air hoses aren't tangled
6. Floor is clean and free of debris or protrusions

Operational Safety Checks

1. Someone is constantly holding onto object when air skates are inflated
2. Hoses connected to air skates do not get tangled when moving around.
3. Maintain control of load

Do not Overload the weight

Do not Overload the psi

Do not Ride around on the skates

Housekeeping

1. Keep out of the way once finished with
2. Wind up hoses when done

Potential Hazards

- Someone could trip on them
- Air bag bursts during lift
